Three times medical issues came up and Adam was available in the pinch to provide a ride. When freeze-up came in October we had flown 90 hours on floats and then changed to wheels. When an ample snow base had built up by November it was time to changeover to skis, and not having any ski time Adam spent several days out practice landing and maneuvering, I believe him when he says planes are more difficult to control without brakes.

As we met new and different people this year and shared our reasons for being in Alaska there were two invitations for Adam to share at local churches Sunday mornings; many people were interested to hear the stories from their own "backyard."
