It seemed a daunting task to travel with two little ones, Miriam turned three months old the day we began our trip, but we were surprised when Sabrina tripped down some steps and hurt her ankle! It happened during our second week of travel and on a Saturday but the small amount of swelling didn't rush us to the hospital. We learned Monday from an x-ray the entire story, partial fractures in two places, ouch! The purple cast from below her knee to above her toes had to stay on for three weeks. While traveling commercially to catch up with Adam the girls met many people in the airports as help was offered to "the poor thing with a broken ankle." This trip was full of good times



and bad: Adam's Grandfather (on his Dad's side) passed away February 18th after battling cancer. While in Georgia we were able to visit with him and spend a few hours watching Sabrina and Miriam win their great-grandfathers' heart.

A few statistics:

- Landed at 33 airports
- 10,000+ statute miles
- 1,130 gallons of fuel

Lyndy and girls arrived a few days later.
