#### Ministry



Throughout the year Adam has been able to assist KIAM with their need for a pilot and mechanic. An unexpected engine overhaul put him to work for several days and during the summer he made a number of flights, including a two-week span of outreach trips to local villages. It was a superb time to get out and meet a lot of folks that have listened to the radio for years but Adam and the others had never met. The trip also fanned the desire to get out with our own plane and follow-up the radio stations ministry. We have had several positive contacts with people living in remote areas and are encouraged by the invitations to, "come out for a visit some time." We want these trips to be an opportunity for encouragement, answering questions, spiritual growth, and continuing friendships for everyone involved.



#### Housing

Our cabin is a wonderful blessing and this year brought it many changes. When we originally built it our intention was to move it to leased property at the local airport. As time passed we realized having it there would be impractical and started looking in Nenana for land that would provide electricity, phone and water/sewer hookup. We found a corner lot that would be perfect and moving the cabin was an "exciting" first for Adam. We also knew some adjustments needed to be made on the inside to accommodate our second baby coming in October: our solution was to extend the loft into a full second floor. The upstairs is now large enough for our beds and the bathroom Adam added this summer. Installing the water/sewer involved days of unforeseen work when the mains were deeper than expected and the trenches began to collapse because of ground water. Our "mobile home" is now connected to all of the amenities and we are enjoying having a bathroom and running water in the kitchen.



#### Airplane

After waiting two-and-a-half years for the airplane we decided to step back into line and take order of an M7. The projected timeline for the improved M9 continued to grow while its weight increase began to dwindle. Since that decision our airplane has zipped through production and is in the last stage of paperwork before delivery this month. It's exciting to know we are closer to having the airplane to use. We expected to pay the cost of having the floats and skis shipped to us but an opportunity arose at the end of August to make a trip to North Carolina/Georgia to pick up an '89 Suburban donated to us. While driving it home Adam stopped at the respective factories and took delivery of the floats and skis, saving us thousands even with the purchase of a trailer to haul everything on.
