We have completed the "U.S. Tour 2000", arriving in Georgia after 20K miles in seven months. It has been a wonderful time visiting with all of you and catching up. We are sorry that we were not able to visit everyone that we wanted to.

What was our route from Washington State? First stop was in Oregon then on to Idaho, Montana, South Dakota, Minnesota, Iowa, then to Illinois. From there it was to Michigan, Indiana, and Ohio.



Pennsylvania was next followed by Virginia, and North Carolina, ending in Georgia. Totalling twenty-nine different states since January! One thing that we did on this tour was take time to smell

the roses, taking advantage of all the cross country driving to stop and see a lot of the traditional tourist stops across the U.S. We also tried to stay off the Interstates as much as possible. This helped keep Lyndy from getting sick and made the drive much more enjoyable. We determined that this will probably be our last BIG trip around the U.S., it will be too difficult to do this with kids in tow.

Update on the New Addition

Now for the BIG NEWS!

As if having a baby in December is not big enough, wait until you hear this. We have placed an order for the airplane! Does this mean that we have all of the money? Not exactly, however we have enough for a down payment and that will get the airplane on the way. We still need to raise funds but God has supplied. A supporter has committed to underwrite the purchase of the plane and a hangar to put it in. What that means is that when the final payment is due they will make up any deficit.

The last week in July we went to the factory in Moultrie, GA. and meet with the wonderful folks there. Everyone was very helpful in answering our questions and went out of their way to make sure that everything was taken care of. We wanted to make sure that everything was right from the beginning and have every confidence that the airplane will long out live our ability to use it. With over 100 planes ahead of us and an average production rate of two a week we expect to take



delivery of the airplane in September 2001.

There are several advantages to not having the airplane until next fall. Perhaps the biggest is that Maule has some improvements that are in development. We pray they will be certified by the time our production number comes up. (Gross weight increase and landing gear/brake line improvements) Another advantage is that we will have time to build a hangar in Alaska next summer. Yes we will need help with construction, so be thinking about coming up to help!

Plans Until Then

We are planning a two-week trip to Alaska in September to talk with the city of Nenana about leasing a property at the airport. We will also plan to get things lined up with contractors so we can break ground as soon as it thaws next spring! Of course we will take time to visit with friends and let everyone know that we have not forgotten about them.

We will be teaching a College/Career Sunday school class and will also be active in other ways at Adam's home church.
